Hollowfibre Fill

Tencel Fill

Tencel is extracted from the raw material, wood. It naturally absorbs moisture and quickly releases it again to guarantee a pleasantly dry sleeping climate.

Microfibre Fill

The finest luxury synthetic alternative to feather and down. Conforms excellently around the head and neck and offers rich, soft, comfortable support.

Polyester Fibre Fill

Synthetic pillows typically have a shorter life span and will not conform to the head and neck as well as natural fill pillows. Overall, the most affordable type of pillows.

Quallofil Fibre Fill

Made of special fibres that slip past each other to allow the pillow to mould perfectly to the head and achieve maximum fluffiness.

Natural Fill (Feather and Down)

Natural fill is feather, down, or a combination of both. These more natural fills are best for conforming to the head and neck.

Estlon Fibre Fill
